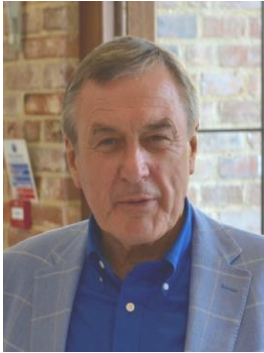


BVH&PFT CIO Trustees and Officers
